Our Topic for this term, is Toys over Time'. This is a history-based topic focusing on the changes in toys over time, looking at a range of sources and using historical language of the past and present. As part of our topic we will also be designing and making our own teddy.

As scientists, we will be looking at every day materials and finding out what would be the best material for teddy's rain coat.

In literacy we will be reading and learning the story of Jack and the Beanstalk.

In maths we are working with 2 digit numbers. We will look at tens and ones. We are learning to count in steps of 10 and recognising the value of coins.

Home reading – Reading at home is a crucial element to ensure your child has a love for reading and becomes a confident reader. Please continue to read on a daily basis. This half term we have changed the home reading scheme. The children will bring home a book to enjoy for pleasure and then a phonic decodable book that practises sounds they have learnt the previous week.
