Sports Activities

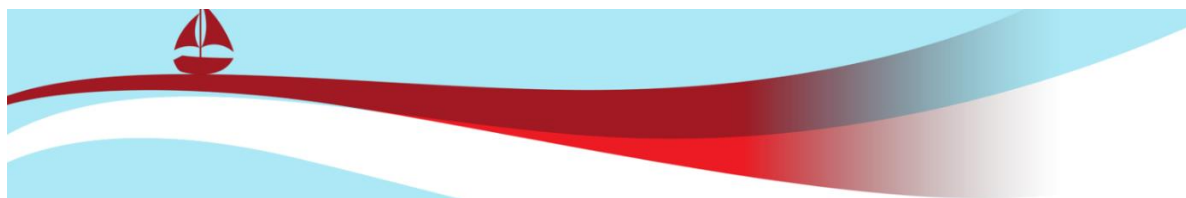
