

It is crucial your child is on time for school. If your child is going to be LATE, please call the school office, if possible, to advise and to book a school lunch (if needed)

Please ensure you are on time picking your child up at the end of the day. Teachers are not always available to wait with your child. If you are going to be late, please call the school office. If you are not here at 3.15pm your child will go into after school club and you will be charged.

Attendance



In order that the school may follow national guidelines, we offer you clear guidance on how you should proceed when your children are either absent or late.

- ALL ABSENCES from school require:

1. A telephone call to the school before 9.00 am on the morning of each day's absence. By calling every day, we can be sure of your child's whereabouts and that they are safe. This also helps ensure all absences can be recorded accurately. Please do not message about pupil absence on class Dojo, as this can cause delays in us receiving absence notifications.

2. Upon your child's return, written and signed confirmation explaining the absence, including any medical evidence from a doctor. If evidence is not provided the absence may not be authorised.

3. Please try to arrange dentist, doctors or hospital appointments out of school hours. We understand that this is not always possible, in which case, please bring children to get their mark first and ensure your child comes back to school after the appointment. Again, please provide evidence for this.

Breakfast and After School Club

As a lot of you know, we offer wrap around care for the children at the school. Clubs are available to all children and offer a wide range of activities, such as homework club, baking, arts and craft and more.

If you are interested in booking a place on either Breakfast or After School Club, please log onto SchoolMoney to do this, as bookings should be paid for at the time of selection. Please contact the school office if you need a password reset or require any help with this.
