# What are we learning

Our book for this half term is 'The Little Red Hen'. The children will retell and sequence this story and use it as a stimulus for their writing.



# **Phonics & Home reading**

The children are continuing with the Read Write Inc phonic programme. The main focus of this term is for children to increase their fluency when reading. Some children will begin to learn Set 2 sounds with the special friends ay, ee, igh, oa, oo.

Reading books will continue to go home on a Friday and be returned on Thursday. Please continue to encourage your child to read at home to develop their independency, confidence and love for reading.
