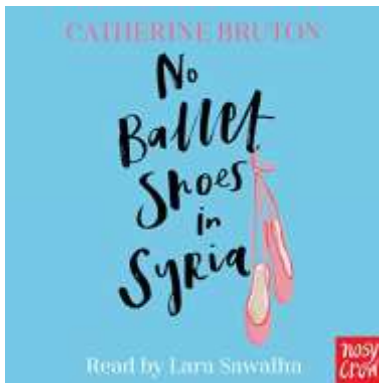
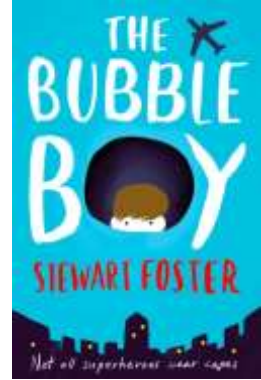
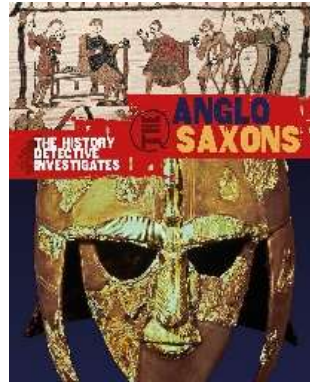
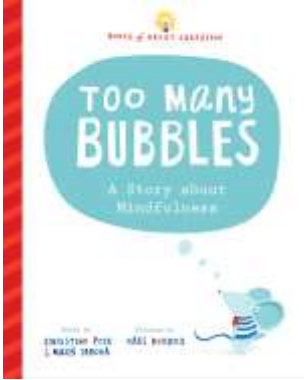
Homework -Homework is set on a Friday and should be returned the following Thursday. If you have any questions about this, please message via class dojo.
