School Uniform - PE Kits

Physical Education (PE) is an integral part of the curriculum, promoting physical fitness, motor skills, and overall well-being. Proper attire, including PE kits, ensures your child's safety and comfort during physical activities. We have noticed recently that we have a high number of pupils not wearing PE kits.

PE kits are designed to provide the necessary support and protection during physical exercises, reducing the risk of injury. Proper footwear, for example, offers stability and cushioning, essential for activities like running and jumping.

Changing into PE kits promotes good hygiene practices by keeping regular clothing clean and sweat-free. Additionally, wearing the designated attire instils a sense of belonging and confidence among students, fostering a positive attitude towards physical activity.

PE Kits requirement:

- Black shorts and a white T Shirt
- Tracksuit top or hoody and tracksuit bottoms
- Trainers

Please can you support us with this going forward. The children can bring their kit at the start of the half term and take home just before the half term break for washing.

School drop off and pick up

We politely remind all parents that parking on site, on the Ashcourt private road or in the Ashcourt student car parking spaces is strictly prohibited, unless you have registered a blue badge with the school office. If the Ashcourt gate off Cottingham Road is open, you should still refrain from entering their student accommodation site. In recent weeks we have had several reports of dangerous driving, near misses and of cars mounting the footpath to park on Ashcourt land. This is, of course, dangerous for those using the footpaths. We have also had instances when staff haven't been able to get into work due to cars blocking up the road and entrances. Please ensure you park off site and walk into school using the pedestrian entrance between the Ashcourt road and the crossing. Please also do not bring children through the Ashcourt office entrance gate due to their residents entering and exiting the site in vehicles at all hours.
