This term, we will continue to look at World War Two and take part in a local history study by looking at the lives of the children who were evacuated from St Nicholas Primary School during the war and how else the people of Hull were affected.

Our geography will allow the children to learn how OS maps are and how they are used and what the symbols on these maps mean. We will also go over the points of a compass.

In our science lessons we will be starting to look at light and how we can see the world around us. This will also include how light impacts us with things such as shadows.





DT will allow the children to create their own WW2 inspired badge while also improving our sewing skills. While ICT will teach the children what networks are and how they are used on everyday life.

In English this term, we are reading The Sheep Pig. We will be using this as a stimulus for us to write a narrative.

In maths this term, we will be moving continuing using fractions in our maths and using them in to work out time, measure and capacity. Please continue to encourage your child to use Times Tables Rockstars at home to help consolidate these important facts, especially as the children move closer to Year 4, where they will take part in a multiplication check.
