School Uniform Reminder

- Children must not wear hoop earrings.

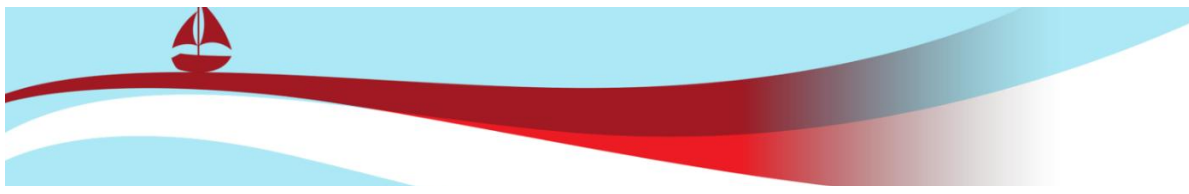
School Uniform - PE Kits

Proper attire, including PE kits, ensures your child's safety and comfort during physical activities. We have noticed recently that we have a high number of pupils not wearing PE kits.

PE kits are designed to provide the necessary support and protection during physical exercises, reducing the risk of injury. Proper footwear, for example, offers stability and cushioning, essential for activities like running and jumping.

- Trainers

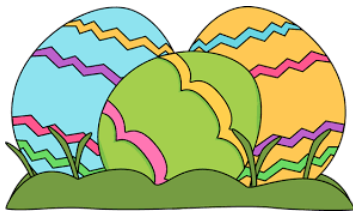

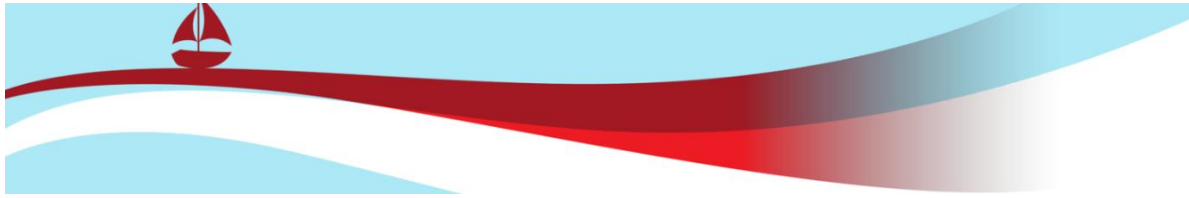
Mr Turnbull
